

BYE-LAW 36 - Poster Code

- B36.1** Posters may be used to promote University and non-commercial, Student and Staff activities free of charge.
- B36.2** Posters may only be posted in designated areas as follows (and NOT walls, facias, signs etc.):
- B36.2.1. LUSU Club, Society, Election and JCR posters may be posted on pillars on the spines and Alex Square (except on pillars where a poster case exists)
 - B36.2.2. Other Posters will be displayed in Poster Cases and distributed via LUSU.
 - B36.2.3. All small ads/classified posters will be distributed via LUSU.
 - B36.2.4. Posters MUST NOT be pasted
- B36.3** LUSU Club, Society, Election and JCR posters
- B36.3.1. Must be properly secured with tape to pillars.
 - B36.3.2. No more than a total of 2 posters may be on each side of a pillar (or a total of 4 on circular pillars)
 - B36.3.3. No campaign/event may have more than 50 posters (except elections)
 - B36.3.4. Poster advertising specific events must be endorsed with the date of posting. This date must be visible and at least 2cm high.
 - B36.3.5. All posters should have a week or date of posting and will be valid for one week.
- B36.4** No posters are permitted in kitchens and residential corridors, except with the explicit permission of residents.
- B36.5** No poster shall use offensive language, or attack named individuals or groups in the University.

- B36.6** No poster shall break Union policy (ie it may not be sexist, racist, homophobic etc).
- B36.7** Only Athletic Union and AU clubs shall use the AU designated notice boards
- B36.8** Any legitimate group wishing to poster in designated areas may remove posters that have expired
- B36.9** In the event of any group postering over or removing posters that have not expired, a complaint should be made to the Athletic Union President, or Union General Secretary who will then investigate the matter further. These officials may remove any offending poster or authorise any other person to do so.
- B36.10** Offenders may be fined £5.00 per every offending poster. Fines to be determined by the General Secretary with the option for appeal under the complaints procedure as detailed in section 21 of the Union constitution. The student development co-ordinator will keep a record of complaints.
- B36.11** All posters will be removed at the end of intro week, end of terms and at other times at the request of the General Secretary (advance warning will be given).
- B36.12** This code applies to all posters on the campus
