

BYE-LAW 28 – Constitution of the Welfare Committee

- B28.1** The Welfare Committee shall be a sub-committee of the Union Council.
- B28.2** Membership
- B28.2.1 The membership of the committee shall be as follows:
- B28.2.1.1 the Welfare Officer of the Union in the chair;
- B28.2.1.2 the Welfare officers of each College JCR, including the GSA;
- B28.2.1.3 the Disabilities Officer of the Union;
- B28.2.1.4 An Equal Opportunities Committee Member;
- B28.2.1.5 the welfare campaigns officer;
- B28.2.1.6 the nightline chair.
- B28.2.2 A member of Advice Centre Staff shall take minutes. Other relevant Advice Centre staff may also be invited.
- B28.3** In addition to the above, there will be room for three co-options at the committee's discretion.
- B28.4** The Welfare Committee shall have the duty to:
- B28.4.1 agree the use of Union Welfare budgets;
- B28.4.2 monitor the welfare provisions provided by the Union and ensure their efficient running, the publicity of education and welfare provisions and the co-ordination of such provisions;
- B28.4.3 consider and promote additional measures welfare provision as it thinks fit;
- B28.4.4 monitor the welfare provisions provided by the University.
- B28.5** The Welfare Committee shall meet at least twice each academic term. At least three days written notice shall be given of each meeting.
- B28.6** The quorum of the Welfare Committee shall be at least five of its members and no business shall be transacted unless such a quorum is present.
