

BYE-LAW 37 – Implementation, Development and Monitoring of the Value Statement

- B37.1** There will be a Values and Ethics Group established consisting of elected officers, staff and volunteers who will be responsible for:
- B37.1.1 The development of a code of practice and to implement, uphold, monitor and develop both the Values Statement and the Code of Practice;
 - B37.1.2 Regular discussion of the values and ethical issues arising within the organisation and externally;
 - B37.1.3 Reporting to Union Council and other interested bodies;
 - B37.1.4 Informing the work of LUSU through debate, surveys and research;
 - B37.1.5 Ensuring all new staff, officers, volunteers, partners and suppliers receive induction regarding LUSU's values;
 - B37.1.6 Bringing to the attention of the appropriate bodies within [and outside of] LUSU, breaches of the value statement;
 - B37.1.7 Working closely and liaising with the Environment Committee.
- B37.2** The membership of the group should consist of the following:
- B37.2.1 The trustees of LUSU
 - B37.2.2 The General Manager
 - B37.2.3 2 members appointed by Union Council [1 to be the Green Officer]
 - B37.2.4 A member of staff to be appointed by the General Manager
 - B37.2.5 A member of staff to act as Secretary to the group
 - B37.2.6 A member with a professional interest in ethics [eg from IEPPP]
